-  Water and non-perishable food
-  Flashlight and extra batteries
-  First aid kit
-  Battery-powered or hand-crank weather radio
-  Extra cell phone battery / portable power bank
-  Personal hygiene items
-  Copies of important family documents in a waterproof container
-  Cash in small bills
-  Local maps and a compass
-  Fire extinguisher
-  A whistle to signal for help
-  Face masks, work gloves, and hand sanitizer
-  Garbage bags for waste disposal and moist towelettes for sanitation
-  Feminine hygiene products and infant care items, if needed
-  Waterproof matches
-  Warm blankets and extra clothing
-  Non-prescription medications such as pain relievers and antidiarrheal tablets
-  Prescription medications (in labeled containers) and items such as inhaler and spare eyewear for family members who need them
-  Books, puzzles, or games for children
-  Pet supplies if needed
-  Waterproof notepads, pencils and pens
-  Extra keys for vehicles and or residence
-  Blankets or sleeping bags
